

Nursery admissions

1. When can my child start nursery?

Children can start from their 3rd birthday.

2. Will the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) and KS1 (year 1 and 2) children be learning in the same environment?

Since the last academic year we have enhanced facilities to enable separate rooms for EYFS and KS1. KS1 children will have a separate classroom for focussed activities.

3. Do the current staff have the relevant qualifications?

Miss Stringer is a qualified teacher, Mrs Bailey is a qualified nursery nurse and a higher level teaching assistant and Mrs Scott is also a qualified nursery nurse and learning support assistant.

4. What knowledge do the staff have of under fives?

Miss Stringer is an EYFS Lead teacher for NYCC who has experience of working with children from 4 years. Mrs Bailey has previously worked as a child minder and achieved Outstanding as an early year's practitioner from Ofsted.

5. Can my child have a rest during the school day?

In the EYFS classroom we have a quiet area with sleeping mats. Children can have a sleep during lunch time if required.

6. Do you have nappy changing facilities?

We have a designated nappy changing area in the Purple Room. If your child is in nappies we will send you information about our policy.

7. How can I use my funding?

Options	Hours	Funding
1: Free Hours	3 hours	This will not affect your funding. We are offering 3 free hours to aid transition into school.

2: Share your funding	1-15 hours	You can share your funding between ourselves and another setting.
3: Full funding	15 +	If we receive your full funding your child can attend full time with no extra charges.
4: Extra hours	Any amount	You can pay for extra hours if you are using your funding elsewhere. We charge £4.60 per hour.
